There are a lot of good foods out there, but I don't recall one gaining the confidence of so many of the top mushers and in the mushing community at large in such a short amount of time. I've fed it for a few seasons now, and was in the first group of mushers to try it.

Both the Momentum and the Pursuit have worked well for my dogs. Their coats look good, they gain weight easy on it, and digest it well. It works well with meat or without. A good way to try it out is to buy a bag & feed a thin or pregnant/lactating dog with it and you will get an idea of how well it would work for the rest of the team.

With Dr. Tim having race veterinarian experience and being a top competitor himself, he gets feedback about how the food works every day he trains. He also keeps an open ear to what input the mushers feeding it give him, and has been open to tweaking the dog food, aiming for the perfect sled dog food. That's something that's rarely going to be possible with the bigger companies. You know if it works well for sled dogs, it's going to be great for all sporting dogs and any dog you want to have the best nutrition.
